Personal information on Epi-Care epilepsy alarms

I hereby confirm, that our epilepsy alarms, herein included Epi-Care free, Epi-Care free GSM and Epi-Care mobile, do not send any personal information to any other receiver than the care phone, to which alarm calls are sent.

The algorithm is performed in the sensor only. In case of a seizure, only a start time of the algorithm output exceeding the alarm threshold is sent to the caretaker's phone.

According to the EU Medical Device Directive 93/42 Danish Care Technology ApS as the manufacture is obliged to keep record with each medical device sold. We do this in the form of a unique serial number placed on each device.

It is not possible to track personal information, user data or similar through the serial number.

We do not receive any information from the device for example which telephone number it delivers alarm information to, or similar information unless this has is specifically agreed with the user or the users care person.

I also confirm that the algorithm on the Epi-Care free sensor is identical with the algorithm on the Epi-Care mobile sensor and as tested in the clinical report, published in Epilepsia 1-4, 2013.
